LESSONS FROM THE SCHOOL OF INDIGENOUS RELIGION

Ecology is an elite discourse, but permeating people's everyday life. Using a decolonial perspective, this presentation will examine the discourse by engaging every day concerns of people, especially indigenous religion followers. It will elaborate the practice of Indigenous religion school, initiated in 2023, through which their everyday experiences, practices and their cosmological framework are re-formulated as the basis of re-adressing the ecology. Finally, this presentation will highlight a framework of community based ecological engagement as a complement to top-down approaches in responding to ecological challenges.
